Two community wide housing listening sessions will be held in Norfolk this coming Thursday, September 1.

Hanna: Keelan Associates, P.C., a community planning and research consulting firm based in Lincoln will be conducting the sessions to discuss current and future housing needs in the community. All Norfolk area residents are invited to provide input on housing needs and wants.

The Norfolk Housing Agency (NHA) is completing a Community Housing Study with Strategies for Affordable

Housing. The study is funded with a housing grant provided by the Nebraska Investment Finance Authority with additional funds from NHA.

The first listening session will be from 12:00 pm to 1:00 pm and the second session will be held from 5:00 pm to 6:00 pm. Both sessions will be in the City of Norfolk Administration Building – Council Chambers at 309 North 5th Street. Please enter in the northwest door of the building.
