"Open House at the Norfolk Fire Division Sunday"

The City of Norfolk Fire Division is holding an open house from 1:00 pm to 3:00 pm on Sunday, October 9, 2016 at both fire stations located at 701 Koenigstein Avenue and 2920 West Benjamin Avenue. Weather permitting, there will be snorkel rides, treats to eat and tours of the stations.

The week of October 9 through October 15 is Fire Prevention Week. Norfolk Fire Marshal Terry Zwiebel reminds Norfolk residents to look at homes and offices for fire hazards such as overloaded outlets and combustibles stored around any heat producing appliance. All matches and lighters need to be stored out of the reach of children. Never leave anything on the stove unattended. Make sure all smoking materials are extinguished by the use of water before discarding them. Smoke alarms need to be replaced every ten years to ensure they will work properly.
