## “AquaVenture Water Park Progress”



A panoramic view of the Memorial AquaVenture Water Park taken recently shows the zero depth pool on the far left that will contain water features and a water walk of large plastic lilies. Towards the back of the zero depth pool is a catch pool for one of the water slides. The orange toddler slide is ready for placement in this pool.

As the pool stretches to the right, it becomes a recreational pool that will be a catch pool for another slide and will include diving boards, basketball hoops and lanes for competitive swimming.

The mechanical building containing the pool pumps, filter system and chemicals for pool operations is towards the center of the picture.

To the right of the mechanical building is the big play feature with an approximately 10 inch depth pool geared for swimmers ages 5-11. It is connected to the wave pool which is at the far right of the picture. The wave pool also starts with a zero depth entry and the pump that produces the waves is located towards the back of this pool.

Ryan Kucera, superintendent of Veteran’s Memorial Park, said that cement was recently poured in front of the main entry, and electricians and plumbers were working in the multi-purpose building. Work also continues on the water park area in preparation for a mid-June opening.
