“Ta-Ha-Zouka Park Camping Improvements”



Concrete camping pads, a new shower and restroom facility and updated picnic tables welcome visitors to the Ta-Ha-Zouka Park campgrounds this spring.

The improvements were made last fall and final touches were put on the grounds before the camp opened the last week of March.

There are currently 13 concrete pads at the park with electrical

hookups. A new shower and restroom facility that is now American Disability Act accessible sits on the west end of the campground. There is free wireless Internet access at the park and aluminum tables have replaced the wooden tables.

“We needed more amperage to run the campers so we now have new pedestals that provide 20/30/50 amps,” said Ryan Beed, caretaker of the park.

Beed said there have already been many campers from Canada and Minnesota stopping by to stay at the park before they head north. He looks for the campgrounds to get really busy once the schools get out for the summer.

Fees for the campgrounds include \$12 per night to camp without electrical access and \$18 per night to camp on a pad with electrical hookup. There is a seven-night limit and the pads are filled first come, first served.
