“Summer 2014 Street Improvements on the Docket”

Newly conditioned streets are in the plan for parts of Norfolk this summer. City of Norfolk Assistant Engineer Mark Dolechek said that citizens need to be aware of the following street projects that will be ongoing from now through this September. Already this week Victory Road from Norfolk Avenue to Benjamin Avenue has started to get a makeover.



“First the contractors will do concrete patching in damaged or uneven areas. Later on they will mill off a portion of the streets’ concrete surface and fill it in with an asphalt pavement,” Dolechek said.

The plan is for streets in the pavement projects to receive concrete patching this spring with milling and asphalt paving done later in the summer.

Dolechek said the street projects will

necessitate reducing the traffic to one lane at times. A pilot car will be directing traffic at some project locations. At night and during non-working hours two lanes will be opened to traffic.

Citizens are advised to use caution when in construction areas and to use alternate routes if possible.

The timeline for the street projects are: April – Victory Road from Benjamin Avenue to Norfolk Avenue, concrete patching; May - First Street from Bluff Avenue to Madison Avenue, concrete patching; Late May through June - Norfolk Avenue from 14th Street to 18th Street, concrete patching; July through September – milling and asphalt paving on all three street projects.
