“National Night Out Coming Up”



It's a great opportunity to celebrate safety! City of Norfolk Police Division Captain Don Miller has organized the 7th annual National Night Out to be held August 4 from 6:00 pm to 8:00 pm at Central Park at 705 South 6th Street in Norfolk. The event is free to the public and is designed to promote safe and crime free communities.

At the park will be area emergency first responders including personnel with the Norfolk Fire Division, the Nebraska State Patrol, the Madison County Sheriff's Office and the Norfolk Police Division.

They will provide safety information and demonstrations. Area businesses have donated food with games planned for kids and representatives from nearly 40 different organizations will each man a table of information on services offered in the Norfolk area.

It was organized to: (1) heighten crime prevention awareness (2) generate support for, and participation in, local anticrime programs (3) strengthen neighborhood spirit and police-community partnerships and (4) send a message to criminals letting them know that neighborhoods are organized and fighting back.
