## “1900 Sign up for Summer Reading Program”



Participants don't just read in the Summer Reading Program at the Norfolk Public Library. On Friday morning, over 90 children also competed in the Nursery Rhyme Olympics, which included events such as jumping over the Jack Be Nimble Hurdles and hopping in the Baa Baa Black Sheep Sack Race.

“We had planned on having it outdoors but moved it inside because of the rain. When you hear laughter and the kids telling each other they're having fun you know the event is still a success,” said Karen Drevo, Youth Services Specialist at the library.

Nearly 1900 readers of all ages have signed up for the summer reading program which includes activities from May through August such as magic shows, hula hoop games and next week – a raptor show.

“On July 22 at 10:30 am we're going to have the Fontanelle Forest Raptor Recovery Team bring three live raptors they have nursed back to health and tell how they provide care and support for injured and orphaned raptors to prepare them for release,” Drevo said. The event is free and open to the public.
