"Police Auction Will be Held July 28"

Another police auction will be held this year following a successful event held last summer that raised \$3,700 – much of it given to the Norfolk Public Schools. On July 28, 2016, 5:00 pm at the City of Norfolk Police Division on 202 North 7th Street, Norfolk auctioneer Gary Bretschneider will again auction off a variety of City items. They include used desk furniture, a lawn mower, a refrigerator and a lot of bicycles.

"We auctioned off more than 50 bicycles last year and we've collected another 60 that have been abandoned since



then. We store a lot of items hoping some one will come along and claim them. No one does so we are going to auction them off," said Julie Knudson, Property Officer for the Police Division.

Last year, over 150 people from as far away as Shickley, Nebraska, obtained numbers to buy a variety of items at the auction including cameras, vehicle seats, DVD players and jewelry.

Although the money from items put on the auction from other City divisions goes to the City's general budget, much of the total, by Nebraska State Statute, goes to the Norfolk

school system.
